5. Type of pets that can enter are: cats, dogs, birds, pocket pets (e.g. guinea pigs, rabbits, rats, mice etc) and if have a charmasitic reptile or fish they can too!
Any other animals other than the above, unfortunaley can not enter only because to get them a decent prize will be a bit difficult for us and likely go over our prize budget! But you can still submit any photos to go into our gallery on our website.
6. Please note the dates of the competition intake and send your entry accordingly, just so we don't get ourselves in a muddle and everything runs nice and smooth!
